

MSSLP USBE Grant

The Utah State Board of Education is offering a scholarship opportunity for Master of Science in Speech-Language Pathology (MSSLP) students. This scholarship provides financial support for two years in exchange for a two-year work commitment at a Utah public school after graduation.

Scholarship Details:

- **Award Amount:** \$7,500 per year, for a total of \$15,000 over two years (amounts can vary by year).
- **Work Commitment:** Recipients must work for two years in a Utah public school upon graduation. Compliance with this requirement will be monitored through follow-ups.
- **Number of Awards:** Three students from the incoming cohort will be selected.

Eligibility & Application Process:

- Students must submit a **completed application** along with a **written response to an essay prompt**, through the Scholarships Department at Rocky Mountain University of Health Professions (RMUoHP).
- All required documents, including the application, must be submitted no later **than the deadline for that academic year (contact Leslie Garcia)**.
- **Priority consideration** will be given to students who have **exhausted funding options**.

This scholarship is an excellent opportunity for MSSLP students to receive financial support while making a meaningful impact in Utah's public school system.
